

#### Heat and Eat Pantry For Students - by Janice and Julie Kurtz

Our Food Pantry has been approved for a partnership with Cuyahoga Falls High School to operate a "heat and eat" pantry for students who request assistance through their guidance counselors. Most of these students are qualified for the free lunch program; however, the food provided through this program is not sufficient to meet the needs of these growing high schoolers.

The type of food we will be stocking the cupboard with for this partnership are as follows:

- Easy Mac cups
- Dinty Moore entrees
- Heat and Eat Soups -no water required
- Spaghetti-O's
- Granola Bars
- Fruit Cups

Any other shelf-stable lunch type products that can be opened and eaten.

Protein is very important as the free lunches do not provide enough to sustain these children through the afternoon.

We started this program with the Peace and Global Witness Offering that was recently collected and we keep 25% for a local at-risk mission. If you would like to donate to this partnership, please put items in the pantry collection box outside the Chapel – marking bag CFHS. Cash donations are also appreciated as there is a "heat and eat" menu through the Akron Canton Regional Foodbank that we can order from.
